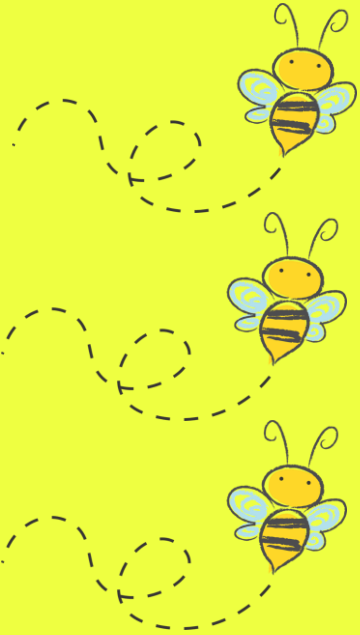

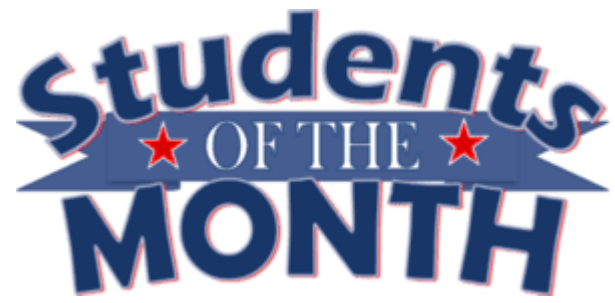

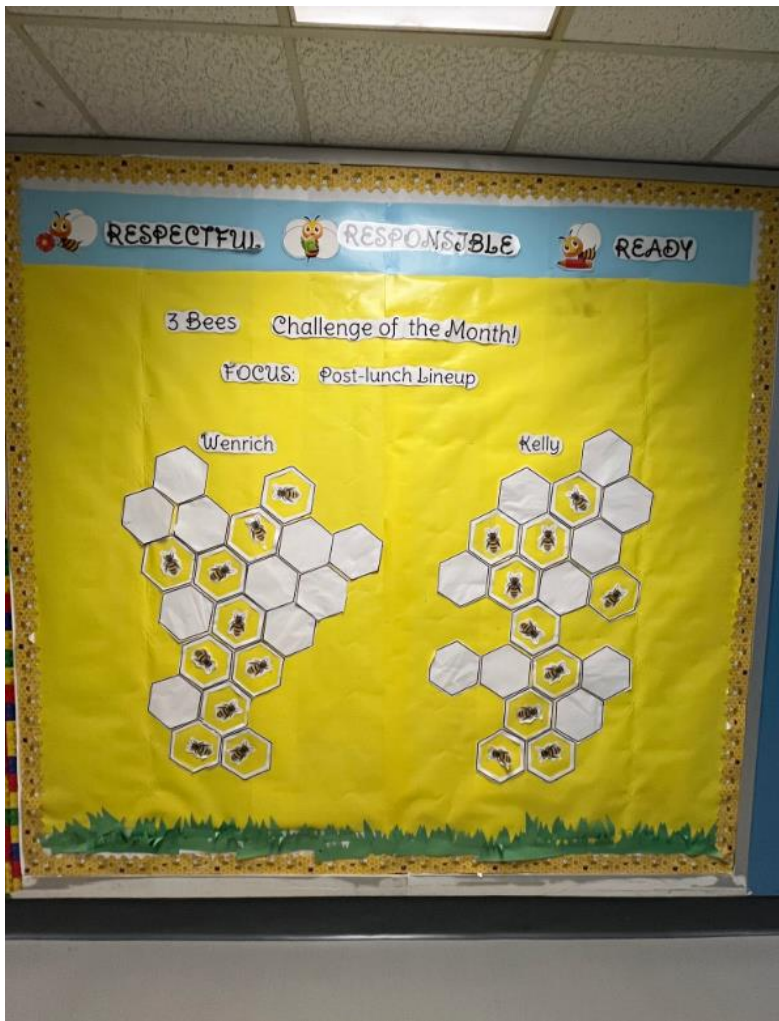

Our 5th graders lead the school with their #3Bs by participating in this #challenge. The goal is to be #respectful, #responsible, and #ready after lunch and in the hallway.

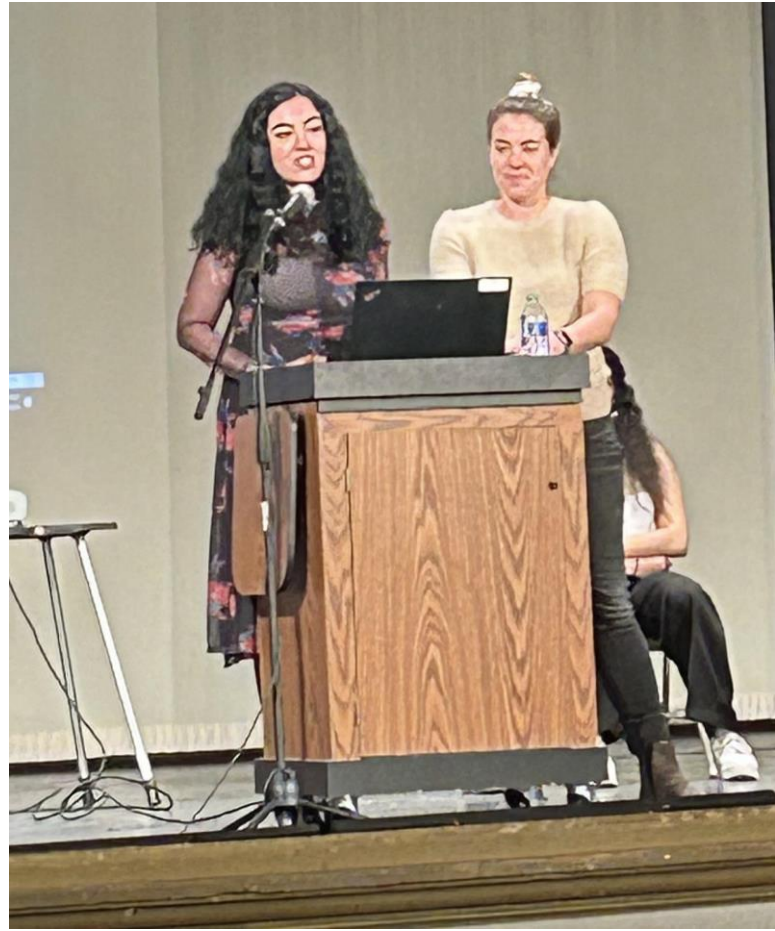

The girls were able to listen to [#inspiring](#) stories of local women. We even had a special guest, a student from our very own [#Carlynton High School](#).



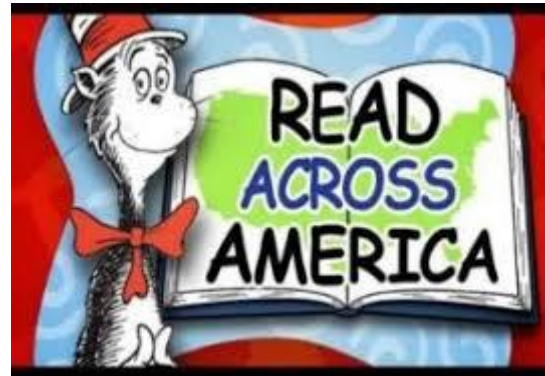
6th graders are **#role** models for our school. Here is a picture of our **#safety** patrols for 2023-2024. We are so **#proud** of these leaders.
