


Notes from Mrs. Barnes' presentation

DUE: April 16th!

To graduate from high school, you **MUST** earn **24 credits**. That's 6 credits each year (freshman-senior years). Notice how the credits break down:



Category	Credits
English	4.0
Social Studies	3.0
Mathematics	3.0
Science	3.0
Physical Education/Wellness	2.5
Electives	8.5

***English- 4 credits

Social Studies- 3 credits

Math- 3 credits

Science- 3 credits

Phys. Ed/Wellness- 2.5

Electives- 8.5 credits


***English courses are **REQUIRED** all four years of study!

Note- "Electives" are classes you **WANT** to take! These should align to your interests and should help to serve the areas you want to explore. Electives also count as classes at Parkway Career Training Center, too!

GOAL: select 6 credits for your upcoming year (2021-2022)

How to schedule:

Go go carlynton.powerschool.com/public



Log in with credentials given to you via email from Ms. Skirtich or Mrs. Barnes for "PowerSchool Account" for your credentials.

Use passcodes provided to initially log in.

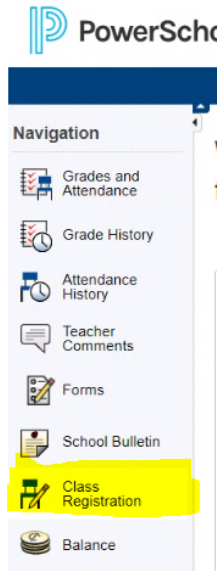
Then, create a NEW password!

Password: first name last name year of grad

Example: stefaniebarnes2024

*(Use the **suggested password format above** in case you forget this later. Mrs. Barnes will be able to best assist you with recovering your password.)*

As soon as you log in, (after changing your password) you'll want to look at the LEFT SIDE MENU to find "Class Registration." Click on this to access available courses for next year.

This is where you'll be able to see a complete list of all subject areas that you'll need to access as you select courses for next year.

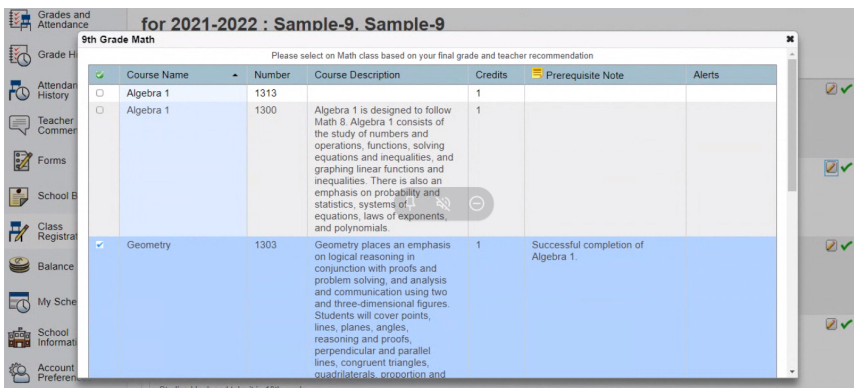
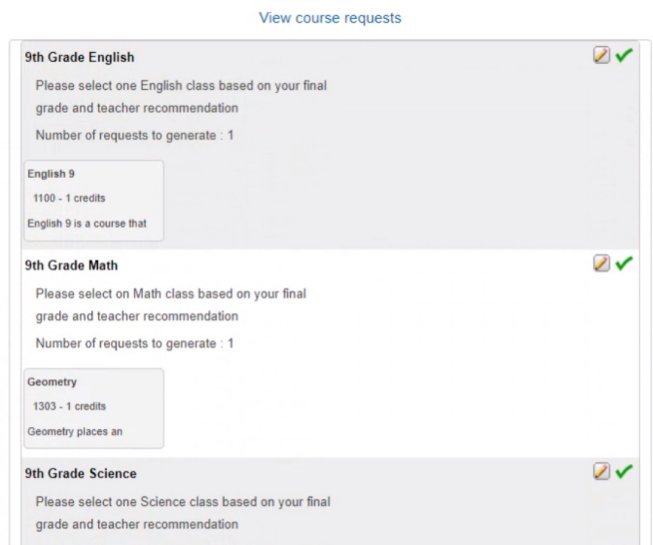
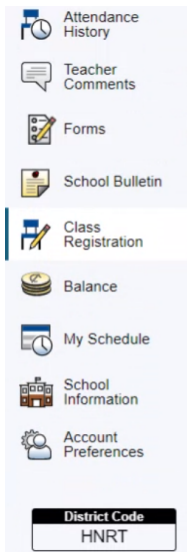


Click on the **top RIGHT** pencil box to access the different levels of each course.

You will then be able to select the appropriate level for English, math, science, etc. for next year's classes.

Don't know which you should select? Speak with your teacher to make sure that you are clicking on the correct level course!

(See example of levels in math below.)



You will edit each class type (English, math, science, social studies, etc.) to select the title of the course you would like to take.

For example, you might select Algebra 1 or Geometry, depending on the next class in which you should enroll.

As you make course selections, you will see that you begin to build a collection of classes that will be used to create your schedule.

NOTE- If you plan on taking classes at Parkway next year, you **DO NOT NEED TO SELECT A SOCIAL STUDIES COURSE!** Your classes at Parkway will cover the history credits you need for graduation.

You will select BOTH Physical Education AND Wellness for this area.

Your desire to enroll in **foreign language or music** is noted as a **priority** in creating your schedule as these classes are offered only at certain times. You **DO NOT** have to take these courses!

You may select a foreign language to study.

NOTE- foreign languages are NOT a graduation requirement, but there are advantages to selecting a language to study.

**Sometimes having a foreign language on your transcript can help you stand out later when applying for colleges or universities.*

Electives are important! You'll select FIRST CHOICE and ALTERNATES for your electives. Make sure that you select as many as apply for each so that you are more likely to get your preferences.

If you did NOT select a Language or a Music, please select your top 4 from this list. If you selected either a Language OR a Music, please select two from this list. If you selected a Language AND a Music, and they are your first choice, do not select any from this list. If Language and Music are not your first choice, please select two from this list. If you select Parkway, do not select any from this list.

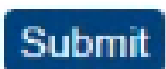
