

## Library Card Opt-Out Form

The Andrew Carnegie Free Library & Music Hall, the Crafton Public Library, and the Carlynton School District are partnering to improve access to educational and recreational materials by issuing a free public library card to all Carlynton students. Only fill out return this form if you do **not** want your student to receive a library card.

A public library card provides access to dozens of online resources and research tools; downloadable ebooks and streaming content; and over a million books, movies, music, games, and periodicals, available for checkout in Allegheny County's seventy-two physical public library buildings.

If your student already has a public library card, they can keep it and will not receive a second card. If their existing card has fines or fees, these charges will be cleared (subject to the discretion of the library that owns the billed items). You remain responsible for returning any physical items checked out from the library.
